3D MODELLING & ANIMATION –

Working for various clients to provide visualisations of complex models and showing the way they work in detail. Examples are Insituform piping, Cultech Omega / enzyme digestion and process, NTRAC organisational promo and various architectural walkthroughs.

2D & 3D CAD –

Providing building plans, office layouts, mechanical / piping / civil drawings and planning permission drawings for various companies including Maris Interiors, Laporte Performance Chemicals, Exxon, Brazier Interiors, Cyanamid and Protech Motorsport.

INTERACTIVE PRESENTATIONS & APPLICATIONS –

Developing 3D models from supplied plans for items not yet in existence or no longer built. This is then supplied in an interactive format as marketing material or as an application that can be used on a kiosk / DVD or small screen device such as a mobile phone. Examples are 62ft and 52ft yachts not yet built for a south coast yacht manufacturer Seastream. This was used in several formats – presentation, marketing DVD, and billboard animation. A second example is The Talking Walls®, currently being developed for the heritage industry. This is a multimedia, visually rich educative application for users to explore their environment through the ages on a small screen device. The British Museum has been very interested in this application as a form of navigation around the museum and for exploring the artefacts in a virtual environment. Currently working with SEEDA and Business Link to develop this ready for funding. Other applications developed during my degree and Masters are waiting to be further developed once The Talking Walls® is completed.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

The Montagu estate at Beaulieu are hoping to proceed with a version of The Talking Walls® for Beaulieu Abbey next year, followed by another application for Buckler's Hard showing the harbour when it was a busy boat yard, with educational material regarding the methods / lifestyle of boat building in the area.

The Talking Walls® won a Commercial Viability award at the Innoventions 2004 Exhibition (Highly Commended).
